The All India Pickleball Association (AIPA) sponsored and organized the clinic in coordination with the Pickleball Federation of Kenya (PFK).



My Vikram Jeet Singh, a certified coach of the AIPA, conducted the training. Mr. Singh provided training to 23 pickleball players of the PFK. A friendly match followed between Indian and Kenyan Pickleball players. Mr. Arvind Prabhoo, IPF President, was very happy about this initiative and informed the IPF membership that the IPF would facilitate such activities worldwide.

The IPF is working toward making pickleball a recognized sport by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) by 2032.
